Chairman Engelmann conducted Hearing at 6:45 P.M. on the proposed intent to consider a petition to vacate a public way in the town of Wausaukee, Marinette County, Wisconsin pursuant to Wis. Stat. Section 66.1003. Located at the end of Wolf Lake Rd. in front of Lots 9 and 10 which is the property of Elaine Howe and Roger Howe more fully described as follows:

All the part of Wolf Lake Road (Birch Tree Drive as platted) located in Lakewood Estates, **Section 18. T. 34N – R21E, Town of Wausaukee, Marinette County, Wisconsin**, described as: commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot 10, Lakewood estates, said point being the POINT OF BEGINNING, thence along the arc of a curve to the left with a radius 66.00 feet and a long chord bearing N82°18'09"E75.44 feet, thence N78°35'58"E39.40 feet, thence S43°03'39"W along the northerly line of Lot 9, Lakewood estates, 113.99 feet to a 2" pipe at the northeast corner of said Lot 10, thence N84°56'58"W61.73 feet to a 2" pipe at the POINT OF BEGINNING, said parcel containing 0.120 acres. A scale map of the land that would be affected was also available. The hearing opened with comments from several property owners in the area of proposed discontinuance.

After discussion of vacating and discontinuing said road was agreed upon. Supervisor Jicha made a motion to pass order to vacate and discontinue Public way; seconded by Supervisor Tomasino. Motion carried.
